Matters Arising	Fund raising and how to increase CGNS awareness in village	
Agenda Items discussed	<p>Accounts: Deb explained that Janet, Chris and herself are now the joint signatories for the CGNS bank account.</p> <p>Janet gave a full account of the finances, which now include the funding from the Parish Council of £160 - £60 for the DBS checks £100 towards the Public Liability Insurance.</p> <p>Public Liability Insurance: Chris confirmed this has been renewed. Janet will reimburse Chris from CGH funds once she has the details</p> <p>Phone: Deb has been in contact with Chris Beszant – he has agreed to talk to O2 when we are ready to transfer the account at the end of September 2017 but it was decided that we would review the need for CGNS if things did not improve.</p> <p>Web site: Deb mentioned that we could get a better deal next year. Chris, Janet and Deb now have access to the website but Gill will continue to keep it updated.</p> <p>DBS checks: There are 4 volunteer’s that will need to be renewed in April, Chris Greenhill, Geoff Bodycote, Marjie Smith and Janet Thompson. Deb will contact them in March.</p> <p>How to increase awareness of CGNS: It was decided that the volunteers would organise a litter pick. We will advertise this on the village notice boards, inviting others to join us. Blaby District Council have agreed to provide some Pick Sticks and as many bags as we need. Deb will source the gloves, high visibility jackets and more Pick Sticks.
